Project Description:

The SW 30th Avenue Paving and Drainage Improvements Project for the Town of Pembroke Park was designed and constructed with matching Community Development Block Grant funds. The 0.4 mile roadway enhancements, from Pembroke Road to Hallandale Beach Boulevard, consisted of regrading and widening an existing two-lane roadway to include parallel parking and a brick paver pedestrian walkway. Work also included drainage installation, harmonization with existing conditions, curbing, sod, fencing, signage and striping. Total design costs including construction management for the project was \$53,250. Total construction cost was \$207,340. The project began preliminary design in 1996, was funded by CDBG in 2000 and completed in October 2002 without liquidated damages.

Responsibilities:

Survey, utility locates, preparation of engineering design and construction plans, cost estimates, contract documents, bidding, construction management and construction observation, certification through project close-out and assistance in securing funding for the project.
