Project Description:

The McNab Road Roadway Improvement Project consists of widening the existing four-lane divided road to a six-lane divided road with additional turn lanes. The one-mile stretch of roadway, from University Drive to Pine Island Road, not only included the reconfiguration of the existing roadway but also consisted of approximately 4,700 LF of pipe culverts, approximately 5,600 LF of exfiltration trench with manholes and inlets, sidewalks, traffic signalization, striping and signage, landscaping, irrigation and street lighting. Total design and construction management costs for the project were \$668,600. Total construction costs were \$4,571,400. The project began in 1999 and was completed in 2006 without liquidated damages.

Responsibilities:

Survey, preparation of engineering design and construction plans, stormwater modeling and permitting, cost estimates, contract documents, bidding, construction management and construction observation, and certification through project close-out.
